

What are carbon credits and what does CLP offer?

A carbon credit is a carbon offsetting tool that can allow you to reduce your carbon footprint. CLP Carbon Credits contribute to the development of renewable energy projects where CLP Holdings Limited (CLP) and its affiliates have equity interests.



Why CLP Carbon Credits?

CLP is a power business based in Hong Kong, with investments across Asia Pacific. CLP originates carbon credits from renewable energy projects, including wind and solar farms, operating in Mainland China by <u>CLP</u> and India by <u>Apraava Energy</u>, a 50:50 joint venture between CLP and Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec (CDPQ).

All these projects are audited regularly and certified by the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) or Verified Carbon Standard (VCS) to ensure their integrity.

When you purchase a carbon credit from CLP, the amount that you pay will be fully used to support the development and operation of the associated renewable energy projects without any brokerage charges or administration fees. Project operations include wages for employees, ongoing maintenance and repairs, as well as local taxes and community programmes.







What are carbon credits for?

Carbon credits have different uses, including:

Offsetting corporate and personal carbon emissions

Carbon credits allow companies and individuals to offset their carbon emissions and demonstrate their commitment to combat climate change. For example, these can be used to offset carbon emissions from marketing events or be presented as souvenirs for guests.

2. Product and/or service bundling

Carbon credits can be incorporated into your product and/or service offerings to help attract climate-conscious customers.

While carbon credits can be used to offset emissions, different climate commitment frameworks may have different requirements for greenhouse gas accounting or the acceptance of carbon offsets.
